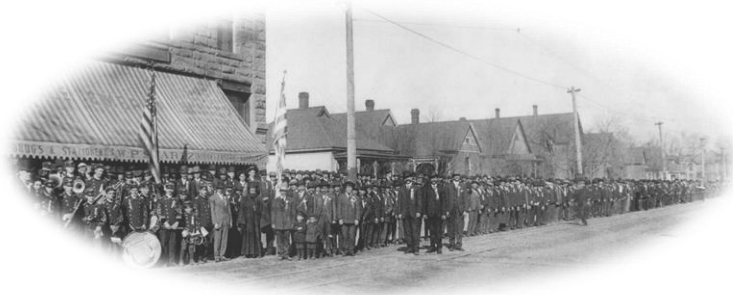

Pueblo Chieftain Neighborhood Articles:

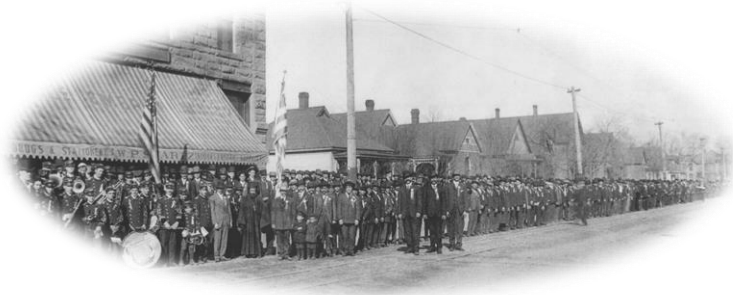

I-25:

Joe Dehart, from CDOT, has indicated that CDOT has completed negotiations with Flatirons Construction for the construction of the Ilex Interchange. Project work will commence in March. CDOT will renovate the Northern Avenue and Mesa Avenue Bridges, repairing sidewalks, railings, and fencing.

EPA:

The EPA testing consent forms will include a separate questionnaire asking about the construction of the home. Western Technologies, the consulting firm, is also requiring the tenant to sign the consent form for clean-up.
