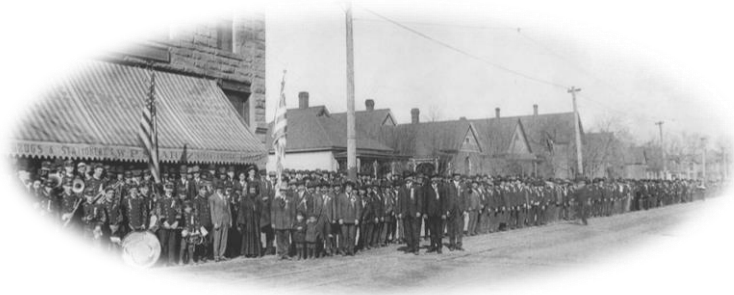

Do Drop Fundraiser:

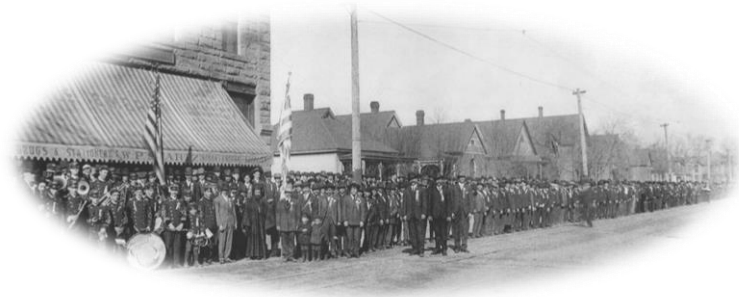
Money for the fundraiser should be turned into Donna at the Do-Drop. The fundraiser will continue and all proceeds will be used for the bulletin board.
