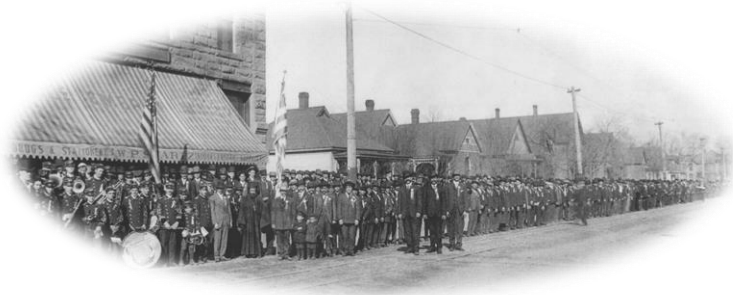

DVD: \$15.00,

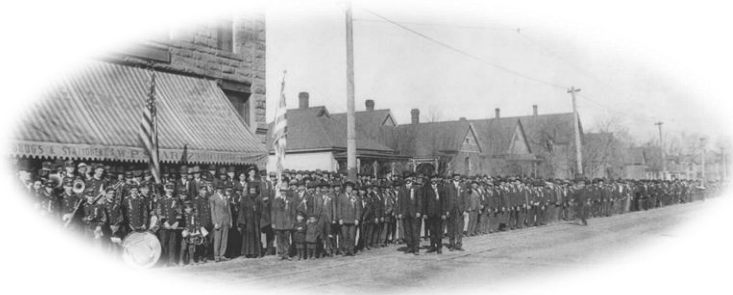
Results of the study concluded that the neighborhood is eligible to be included on the National Register of Historic Places. In researching the possible designation, President Pam Kocman, has discovered that with the designation some home owners may face difficulties with their home-owners insurance. It has come to Ms. Kocman's attention that some insurance companies may not agree to insure a Federally Registered home.

Bulletin Board:

Stanley is finished with the flowers and they have been painted. Gary is getting close to finishing the box, which will need to be stained. The bulletin board will be installed in September or October by the City of Pueblo. President Pam Kocman posed the question whether the Neighborhood Association would like to host a dedication ceremony? Discussion focused on dedicating the bulletin board the weekend of October 18th.

Do Drop Fundraiser:

Money for the fundraiser should be turned into Donna at the Do-Drop. The fundraiser will continue and all proceeds will be used for the bulletin board.



Events:

- Kurjia Vas-Our Chicken Coops, Scavenger Hunt, Coffee and Cookie Social, and Bulletin Board Dedication-Neighborhood residents discussed whether there should be a couple of events on different days for the race, dedication and scavenger hunt. Following much discussion and a vote it was decided to consolidate activities in a central location on one day in October. The dedication and social will take place on October 18th, in an available commercial location along Santa Fe Avenue. President Pam Kocman is going to contact the property owners along Santa Fe Avenue to determine the best available location. If the Kurjia Vas timed run can be organized it will take place on the same date.

- Flag Raising on Veteran's Day-Neighborhood residents discussed the possibility of hosting a early-morning Flag Raising Ceremony at St. Mary's Church on Veteran's Day.

- Neighborhood Vision-The Neighborhood Association will work on developing a vision for the neighborhood to guide activities and events within the neighborhood.
